



THE 2010 MASTERS APRIL 10 - 13, 2010

Let us be your ticket to golf's most prestigious (and impossible-to-get-into) event. Spend the final day of the Masters walking alongside the best golfers in the world as they pursue the coveted green jacket, then celebrate victory in the shelter of our VIP Hospitality suite. SATURDAY APRIL 10. Fly into Atlanta and make your way to the Ritz-Carlton, Buckhead. The Ritz-Carlton Buckhead is the Rolls Royce of Atlanta hotels. Spend the rest of the day following your favourite world-class golfers across the pristine contours of the emerald course as they pursue the hallowed green jacket, or escape the crowds and enjoy a bounty of food and refreshments at our constantly changing hospitality buffet. Following the presentation ceremony, return to the hospitality facilities to grab a drink or bite of dinner and to return your Patron's Badge. Board our coach for the transfer to the luxurious Ritz-Carlton Reynolds Plantation, in Greensboro, Georgia. Ritz-Carlton Buckhead (Saturday Night)

Ritz-Carlton Reynolds Plantation (Sunday & Monday Night)

Just 75 miles east of Atlanta, the Reynolds Plantation provides guests with legendary Ritz-Carlton service highlighted by gracious southern hospitality. Named among the "World's Best Places to Stay"

by Conde Nast Traveler, the 251-room lodge is secluded on the lazy shores of Lake Oconee with 99 holes of golf designed by the greatest architects of the game, an award-winning Spa with unique southern-inspired treatments blended from under the Georgia pines and exclusive adventures ranging from fishing for large mouth bass (the lake hosted the world championship a few years ago) to waterskiing or canoeing.

WHERE WE PLAY Reynolds Plantation Courses

Reynolds Landing, is the original golf course on Lake Oconee and is centred on a classic Bob Cupp golf course that earned numerous awards when it opened in 1986.

The Oconee Course, the Rees Jones-designed resort course, presents a golfing challenge that is unmatched by any other in the nation.

The National Course, designed by Tom Fazio boasts 27 holes, the National features impressive elevations, wonderful views and several holes skirting the shores of Lake Oconee.

Great Waters, an 18-hole Jack Nicklaus-signature design, winds through densely wooded evergreen corridors only to open up to nine holes featuring the blue waters of Lake Oconee as the rough. Named as one of the best courses in Georgia, second only to Augusta National, Great Waters is one of the most aesthetically inspiring golf courses in the continental United States.

Plantation Course, has been ranked among the "Ten Best New Courses" and is characterized by a natural, rolling layout that possesses innumerable subtleties.
